 Pressurized ballpoint pen


/ Use and Care Guide

The power of pressurization resolves the frustration of not being able to write in various situations.

Clicking the pen compresses the internal air pressure, and the compressed air pushes the ink out.

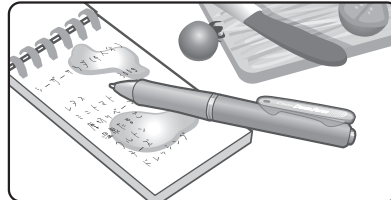


Features



(1) Writes smoothly from the very first stroke!

The ink flows smoothly from the very first stroke and continues to write consistently, even at high speeds.



(2) Writes smoothly on wet paper too!

This pen can write on wet paper without being affected by moisture unlike ordinary ballpoint pens. Ideal for use in damp areas such as the kitchen.

* Depending on the conditions, the ink may blur, or applying too much pressure while writing may cause the paper to tear.



(3) The ink does not flow backward, even when writing upside down!

Even when writing with the pen tipped upward, like when writing on a wall-mounted calendar, there is no worry about being unable to write due to air bubbles in the ink or backward flow, which often occur with ordinary ballpoint pens.

Refill for ballpoint pen

The compatible refill is the PILOT **BKRF-6F**.

* Using a different refill may cause malfunctions, such as ink leakage.

Remarks

- Do not leave this pen unattended without retracting the pen tip. After each use, always press the top of the clip to retract the pen tip.
- If the ink flow stops, it may indicate that the pressurization has not been activated. In such cases, click the top part again.
- Please do not use this product for any purpose other than writing.
- Keep away from children.
- Avoid severe impacts or violent shaking because the ink may leak.
- Note that it may not be possible to remove this ink if it accidentally gets on your clothes.
- Do not store in places exposed to direct sunlight or high temperatures.
