

iroshizuku / Use and Care Guide

The Pilot iroshizuku Series is an elegantly named, luxurious collection of inks designed to reflect the beautiful natural scenery of Japan. Bringing greater pleasure and enjoyment to your writing experience.

USE:

The ink is used in fountain pens and writing pens. Using the ink for purposes other than this is not recommended.

NOTE:

- Only use the ink for writing.
- Keep away from children.
- Please note that even though the ink is water-based, it may stick to or stain clothes and other material.
- Do not expose to direct sunlight or place in hot areas.
- The ink is a chemical. The formulation is different from the inks of other companies even if they are the same color. Never mix inks because doing so changes the chemical composition of the ink.
- When changing the ink color, wash the nib and neck in lukewarm water thoroughly.
- The ink evaporates quickly, so place the cap on the bottle when not in use.
- If ink is ingested by mistake, take measures of drinking water, and if ink enters the eye, take measures of rinsing with water. Consult a doctor after taking these measures.
