

Pigment Ink for fountain pens "Tsuwairo" / Use and Care Guide

Converters compatible with "TSUWAIRO" Please use CON-40 or CON-70N.	This ink cannot be used with the following fountain pens.
Can be used CON-40(Rotary type)	Cannot Screw type be used Custom Heritage 92
Can be used CON-70N(Push type) Internal piece	Cannot Plunger type be used Custom 823

Remarks

- The ink is used for writing with fountain pens or other types of pens. Using the ink for purposes other than those recommended may cause issues.
- Keep away from children.
- Note that it may not be possible to remove this ink if it accidentally gets on your clothes.
- Do not store in places exposed to direct sunshine or high temperatures.
- The ink is a chemical. The formulation is different from the inks of other companies even if they are the same color. Never mix inks since doing so changes the chemical composition of the ink.
- Only use this ink with Pilot products.
- Securely close the cap and invert the bottle vertically four to five times before use.
- Use a CON-40 or CON-70N converter.
- In the CON-70N, lubrication oil may be visible inside, but it does not affect its function.
- This ink cannot be used for lacquer products (including maki-e products), vacuum filler fountain pens, or the Justus 95.
- Since the ink evaporates easily, make sure the cap is properly sealed after use.
- If ink is ingested by mistake, take measures of drinking water, and if ink enters the eye, take measures of rinsing with water. Consult a doctor after taking these measures.
- If you do not plan to use the fountain pen for a while or if you wish to change the color of the ink, use a cleaning solution (sold separately) to thoroughly clean the pen nib and neck.
