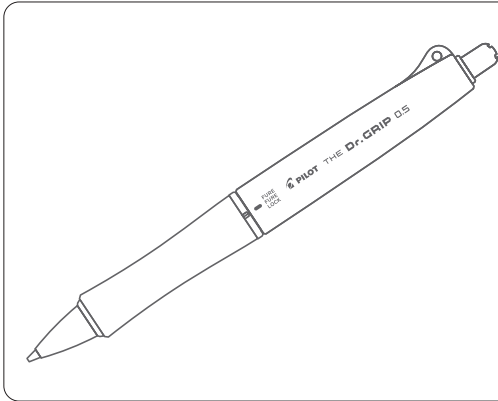

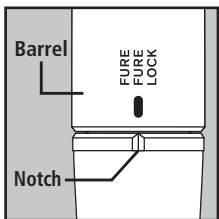

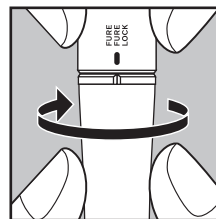
An upgraded Dr. GRIP with reduced mechanical noise and the Fure Fure lock function

- 1. Dr. GRIP**
The ergonomic design enables a comfortable grip that reduces fatigue.
- 2. The quietest design in the series^{*1}**
Compared to the previous model, the mechanical noise generated by clicking or using the Fure Fure mechanism is reduced by about 50%.
(*1) The PILOT Dr. GRIP series
- 3. Fure Fure lock**
Locking the Fure Fure mechanism keeps the lead retracted while the pen is not in use.

How to use the Fure Fure lock



Lock the Fure Fure mechanism.
The Fure Fure lock mechanism can be locked when the FURE FURE LOCK label aligns with the notch on the ring. ^{*2}

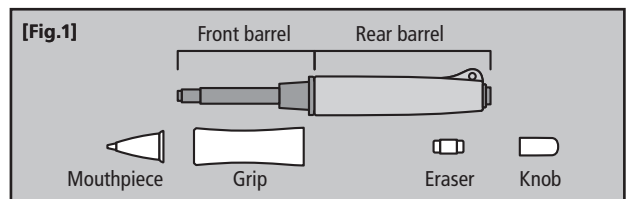


Cancel the Fure Fure lock.
To release the Fure Fure lock, hold the barrel with the mouthpiece facing down and turn the grip to the left. ^{*3}

(*2) The Fure Fure mechanism is locked when the product is shipped. If the pen is shaken vigorously, the lead may extend even with the Fure Fure mechanism locked.
(*3) Avoid over-rotating the grip or applying excessive force to the pen since this may cause a malfunction. We recommend locking the Fure Fure mechanism when the pen is not in use to prevent the lead from accidentally extending.

Regarding the use of the pen

The front and rear barrels of this pen cannot be disassembled [Fig.1]
Avoid disassembling the pen with excessive force because it may damage the pen.



Remarks

- Please do not use this product for any purpose other than writing.
- Handle with care because the point is sharp.
- Do not swallow the parts, such as the knob, eraser, and mouthpiece.
- Keep away from children.
- Do not store in places exposed to direct sunlight or high temperatures.
- Use PILOT lead refills.
- For spare eraser, please use the PILOT **HERF-10**.
