

MULTIFUNCTION PEN / Use and Care Guide

One pen features both a ballpoint and a mechanical pen. A total of four types of PILOT Multifunction Pen series are available: Revolving Type, Click and Twist Type, Click and Button Type, and Slide Lever Type. Please refer to the proper Use and Care Guide before use.


Revolving Type (4+1/3+1/2+1)


How to use the ballpoint pen


- (1) Turn the upper barrel to make the tip come out. Stop the rotation at the color you want.
- (2) To retract the tip, turn the upper barrel in the opposite direction of (1).

How to use the mechanical pencil

- (1) Turn the upper barrel to make the mechanical pencil come out. Press the eraser cap to make the lead come out.
- (2) To retract the lead, press the lead onto the paper while pushing the eraser cap down.
- (3) To retract the writing unit to its original position, turn the upper barrel in the opposite direction of (1).
- (4) Unscrew the eraser cap to use the eraser.








Lever Slide Type (4+1/2+1)


How to use the ballpoint pen


- (1) Slide the lever with the indication mark (B or R) and a refill of the indication color (B=Black or R=Red) comes out.
- (2) To retract the tip, slide another lever.

How to use the mechanical pencil


- (1) Slide the lever with the indication mark and the writing unit for the mechanical pencil comes out to be fixed. Press the cap to make the lead come out.
- * In the case of 4+1 Wood, slide the clip down and the mechanical pencil comes out. Click the clip to make the lead come out.
- (2) To retract the lead, press the lead onto the paper while pushing the eraser cap down.
- * In the case of 4+1 Wood, press the lead onto the paper while pushing the clip down.
- (3) To retract the writing unit, slide another lever.
- (4) Unscrew the eraser cap off to use the eraser.
- * In case of 4+1 Wood, pull out the eraser cap.







Replacing a ballpoint pen refill



How to refill a mechanical pencil with new lead refills

Unscrew the lower barrel to detach. * In the case of LEGNO and RiDGE, hold the upper barrel and pull outthe lower barrel.	Twist and extend the mechanical pencil.	Hold the pen in the upright position and pull the writing unit.

Drop in the replacement lead refills. * Inserting four or more lead refills may cause the guide pipe to clog.	Reassemble the pen by firmly screwing the lower barrel onto the pen.	Reassemble the pen by firmly screwing the lower barrel onto the upper part. * For the Legno and Ridge, reattach the shaft to finish the process.

Refills for ballpoint pens and spare leads for mechanical pencils

- For ballpoint pen refills, please use the PILOT BRFS-10F (ball diameter 0.7 mm), BRFS-10EF (0.5 mm), or BRFS-10M (1.0 mm). For the Slide Lever type, please use PILOT refills BTRF-6F (0.7 mm), BRFS-10EF (0.5 mm), BRFS-10F (0.7 mm), BVRF-8EF (0.5 mm), or BVRF-8F (0.7 mm).
- * The easiest way to find the right ballpoint pen refill is to bring the refill that you usually use as a sample.
- Please use only genuine PILOT 0.5 mm products for the mechanical pencil's lead refills. There are 10 lead refills.

Remarks

- Please do not use this product for any purpose other than writing.
- Keep away from children.
- Do not swallow the parts, such as the knob, eraser, and writing unit.
- To prevent ink leakage, never write with the tip upwards.
- Avoid vigorous shaking or excessive force because this may damage the writing tip or pencil lead refills.
- Avoid severe impact or violent shaking because the ink may leak.
- Always retract the writing tip after use.
- Note that it may not be possible to remove this ink if it accidentally gets on your clothes.
- Do not store in places exposed to direct sunlight or high temperatures.
